Commitment to achieving net zero

Aura Retrofit Ltd is committed to achieving net zero emissions by 2030.

Baseline emissions footprint

Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving net zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets:

- We target a decrease in underlying carbon emissions over the five years to 2030 to 99.254 tCO₂e. This is a reduction of 33% in absolute terms vs our 2025 baseline, and a reduction of 77% in carbon intensity once factoring in planned business growth over that period.
- Over and above this reduction, Aura Retrofit will achieve Net Zero by 2030 by offsetting all remaining emissions as of this date.

Carbon reduction projects

Completed carbon reduction initiatives

We have completed the following environmental management measures and projects over the period 2022-25:

- Solar PV installed on the head office building
- EV charger installed in car park,
- Installation of low-energy lightbulbs and motion sensors
- EV pilots
- Introduction of intelligent route planning software
- Reduction in driver idling
- Use of market-leading waste solution (98% landfill avoidance and lowest carbon emissions per collection).
- ISO 14001 accreditation

Whilst the benefits of these actions endure and are in effect when we perform any contract, none of these have been newly completed or implemented since the 2025 baseline.

Future carbon reduction initiatives

In the future, we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Electrification of the company fleet
- Move to a 100% renewable electricity tariff
- Cycle to Work scheme
- Prioritisation of local/ sustainable supply chain partners and waste facilities (e.g. ISO14001 certified)

Declaration and sign-off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard¹ and uses the appropriate government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting.²

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements (where required), and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard.³
